Telephone — A new telephone call office has been opened at Wherwell. The fee for the use of the call office, including communication with any exchange within a radius of five miles will be 2d. The charge for a call to an exchange between five and seven and a half miles distant will be 4d. Trunk facilities are limited to areas embracing Salisbury, Guildford, Reading and Southampton groups, Bournemouth, Swindon and Devizes and Portsmouth (local). For instance, the total fee for a three minutes conversation with a subscriber at Salisbury would be 9d, and to Southampton 9d.
